The Lonsdale Plaque Unveiling

2pm, Saturday 6th October:

Main Street, Point Lonsdale (free)

The Lonsdale Plaque to be located in the centre of Point Lonsdale next to the playground, will commemorate the life of Captain William Lonsdale.



The Lonsdale Plaque will be unveiled by Lonsdale's great great granddaughter Mrs Cecelia Newman accompanied by a small re-enactment by Colin Mockett, telling the story of Captain Lonsdale's role at Port Phillip.

Soldier and administrator, Capt Lonsdale supervised the founding of the official settlement at Port Phillip from 1836 as Chief Agent of Government, Police Magistrate and Commandant for Port Phillip. He also had specific instructions to protect the local Aboriginal natives and improve their conditions. From 1939 he served under Charles LaTrobe with whom he always maintained a good relationship.
